
We have had to take a deep dive into what surviving might look like. One key bit of thinking (amongst many other plans to be announced) is simply to 'ask for help'. We realise that we are often too DIY, we try too hard to do it all ourselves. This is partially because we understand that it's good for people to just come here and take part in stuff without needing to know how tricky it can be to keep it all going.

We haven't always been great at reaching out to others and simply asking for help, but just now we can't do it all ourselves, we need as much help as we are able to get from funders & our community. At some point we plan a full on fundraising campaign and are in touch with arts charities who have experience of buying properties and can help with ways of means of making this happen BUT in the meantime working on that 'asking the universe / seven steps removed' principle we are just putting this one out there.

We have loads of low & no options & real coffee if you don't want to drink alcohol, every single drink sale helps!



Strap yourselves in for 'Harness': a new queer party dreamt up and delivered by locals for locals. Expect high-tempo electronic euphoria.


Led by Dj's L-ILY & GayBoy, this night is a gender inclusive high impact dose of hard dance by and for the queer community of Newcastle.






